A Very Creepy Count

Three children are standing alone outside a creepy old house on a quiet street. They are Violet, Klaus and Sunny Baudelaire, and something awful is about to happen to them ...

In fact, many awful things happen to the Baudelaire children in Lemony Snicket's books, *A Series of Unfortunate Events*. That is one reason Snicket, whose real name is Daniel Handler, wanted to write them. So, he writes for his young readers just like he would write for adults, including some very unkind people and scary events.

The books – there are 13 in all – were so popular that a studio decided to make the story into a film. *A Series of Unfortunate Events* appeared in cinemas in 2004 and, although it made a lot of money and many people enjoyed it, fans of the books weren't too pleased. The main problem was the bad guy, Count Olaf (Jim Carrey). All he wants is to get his hands on the Baudelaire children and their money! In the books, he is clever and terrifying, but in the film, a lot of people thought he was too funny and silly. That's why fans were pleased when, in 2017, a new TV series appeared. He is dangerous and, even if you have read the books and know what is going to happen, part of you still worries that one of Count Olaf's nasty ideas will work!

The TV series of *A Series of Unfortunate Events* is a fan favourite. It is as dark, clever and funny as the books. Count Olaf is an actor (a bad one!) and so he often dresses up as someone else as part of his plans to steal the Baudelaire's money. So, Harris has to be two characters at the same time, and he does it perfectly.
